Our generous gift was put towards the construction and capital needs within the new Halle Arizona Burn Center at Valleywise Health. Construction continues as scheduled. The Halle Arizona Burn Center at Valleywise Health will open in late 2023 as the epitome of excellence in burn care nationwide and globally.

Sojourner Center will use our gift to support our emergency shelter, transitional housing, and related supportive programming to decrease the community's risk of violence and homelessness for domestic violence survivors like Rose. Emergency shelter, transitional housing, and safety planning continue to be survivors' most urgent unmet needs. Funds will provide safe emergency housing, transitional housing, and case management services to help foster safety and stability and provide relief from the stress of abuse and trauma so participants, their children, and their pets can move toward greater self-care and decreased dependence on their abuser.



Helped a panel, attended and exhibited a booth, organized a rally, donated to the Turkish embassy, helped camp survivors, organized an advocacy event, and bought 50 books.



The Mayo Family Foundation's donation provided 2,600 meals. We are transforming the lives of the homeless, hungry, and hurting. Funds are also used for shelter, clothing, counseling, recovery, hope, and lots of encouragement.

AFGHAN GIRLS NEXT CHAPTER



In 2021, Mayo Family Foundation orchestrated the largest public private partnership rescue effort out of Afghanistan. As a result, in a matter of 147 hours, we rescued 147 Hazara women that are now successfully settled in the United States. The Mayo Family Foundation does active case management.
